## Graduation Class of 2022 – Q&A

When is graduation?

Graduation is **Saturday, May 14** at **10:00 AM** in the <u>field house</u> at Crystal Lake Central High School. This arrangement follows the current COVID-19 guidelines from the CDC, IDPH and MCDH. Should the guidelines change, it may be necessary to make changes to this arrangement.

How many tickets does each student receive?

Each student will receive 6 tickets at graduation practice.

Are additional tickets available if I need more?

At graduation practice the students will be asked to turn in any tickets that they will not use. These tickets will then be redistributed at graduation practice to students that need additional tickets.

Is there additional seating available for non-ticket holders?

The auditorium will have a live video and audio feed of the ceremony in the fieldhouse. Non-ticket holders can watch graduation from the auditorium. The auditorium is air conditioned.

What should my son or daughter wear to graduation?

Graduation is an important milestone and a semi-formal event. Students should plan on wearing their best business casual attire and shoes when dressing up for this occasion (dress, skirt/blouse, dress pants, dress shirt/collared shirt). Jeans, shorts or flip flops are not permitted. Finally, students should not decorate their mortar board / hat in any way.

When will the doors open on Saturday, May 14 for graduation?

Doors will open at 9:00 AM.

At what time must my son or daughter arrive at CLC on May 14?

All graduates must be in the small gym by **9:00 AM** and must be wearing their cap and gown. Students **will not be able** to carry purses or bags, so leave them at home.

When will my son or daughter receive their official diploma?

During the ceremony the students will receive an empty diploma cover. After the ceremony, the students will pick up their actual diploma in the small gym.

Is there handicapped seating and parking available?

Yes. Contact Mrs. Mutchler (mmutchler@d155.org) 815-459-2505 to reserve parking and seating for handicapped individuals. There are no extra seats for this section; these seats would be **included** as part of the 6 tickets that each graduate receives.

When is graduation practice?

Graduation practice is Thursday, May 12 at 9:00 AM.

Is graduation practice mandatory?

Yes. Students that do not attend graduation practice will not be able to participate in the graduation ceremony.

When is the senior breakfast?

The senior breakfast is Thursday, May 12 at 8:00 AM in the CLC cafeteria. Tickets cost \$10 and MUST be purchased by Friday, April 29 online. <u>Senior Breakfast Registration Link</u>. See Mr. Knope in the library on Friday, April 29 periods 1 - 5 if you want to purchase a ticket with check or cash. Students who wish to attend the breakfast celebration but not eat, do not need to purchase a ticket. Breakfast will be catered by 3 Chefs and it will be a breakfast buffet.

Do January graduates need to come to graduation practice?

Yes.

Can students that graduated in January come to the senior breakfast?
