FALL TESTING DATES

On Wednesday, October 16th, CLC will be offering the SAT suite of assessments to all Freshmen, Sophomores and Juniors. Seniors will NOT be in attendance.

Freshmen: PSAT 8/9
Sophomores: Practice PSAT10
Juniors: PSAT/NMSQT
(National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test)

All students should bring #2 pencils (non-mechanical), their student ID and a calculator. Please be aware that College Board guidelines prohibit electronic devices (cell phones, Chromebooks, smartwatches, etc.) from testing rooms.

Testing room assignments will be posted in English classrooms and around the school. If you have any questions about where your testing location is, please see your case manager or school counselor.
